



Dear Trainee,

We would like to invite Specialist Trainees in Dermatology and Histopathology to the **7<sup>th</sup> British Society for Dermatopathology (BSD) Annual Trainees' Workshop** due to be held **on Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> September 2016 in Bristol.**

It will be suitable for both trainees sitting the Specialty Certificate Examination in Dermatology and the FRCPath parts 1 and 2.

The discussion themes for this year's workshop are: **Cutaneous adnexal tumours, Interface (lichenoid) dermatitis and Special stains in dermatopathology.**

The day has an interactive format, comprising: an introductory lecture, viewing histology slides under the microscope, followed by clinicopathological discussion on a selection of 24 cases.

Cases will be of varying difficulty from beginner to expert level. Beginners will maximise the day's educational value if they read a basic dermatopathology textbook and make a prior attempt to see routine cases at their local institutions.

There will also be a set of self-assessment cases for more advanced trainees.

Places are limited to 40, allocated to first 40 applications received with payment. Successful applicants will be notified by email that they have secured a place. Lunch and tea and coffee are included.

The cost is £35.00 for BSD members and £50.00 for non-BSD members, payable by cheque to the "British Society for Dermatopathology".
